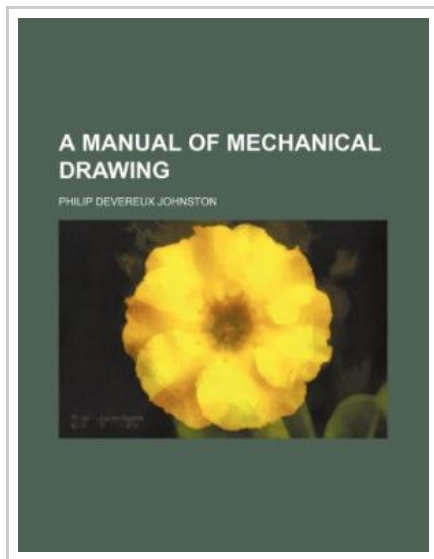

Take distance 1 J in compass, and with the focus as centre sweep arc cutting ordinate 1-1 at 1. In like manner take distance of each ordinate from the directrix, and with focus as centre sweep arcs cutting the ordinates at 2, 3, 4, etc. These will be points in the curve which can be drawn through them. Fig. 15.--Length and breadth being given, to draw the parabola: Construct the parallelogram F E C D. Subdivide the ordinates B C and B D into any number of equal parts; also divide F C and E D into a like number of equal parts. From A draw lines A 1, A 2, A 3, etc., and from B D and...



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
